

SUBJECT: Omega Lowering Opiates Cutoff Levels to 200 pg/mg

Dear Valued Omega Client,

Omega Laboratories has been awaiting the creation of mandatory guidelines by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) regarding the cutoff levels for drugs of abuse testing in hair. Until these cutoff levels are published Omega Laboratories has chosen to lower the screening and confirmation cutoff levels for Opiates and Extended Opiates to 200 pg/mg in an effort to mirror the previously proposed SAMHSA guidelines.

Please be advised that Omega Laboratories, Inc. will be lowering the Opiates screening and confirmation cutoff levels for all standard hair tests effective December 1, 2013. From this date forward, all hair specimen tests will be evaluated at 200 pg/mg of hair cutoff levels for Opiates and Extended Opiates.

Limit of Detection testing cutoff levels will remain unchanged.
